Serving in Emmanuel - Team Expectations

At emmanuel, we are so thankful for anyone who desires to serve alongside others from the body, as we try to reach the lost for Jesus and offer a variety of ministries to meet the diverse range of needs within our church family and local community. By signing up to serve within the church family, we are expecting each person to conduct themselves in the following way:

- 1. To have a personal relationship with Jesus, recognising that all that we do for Him flows out of our encounters with Him.
- 2. To commit to the wider life of the church by regularly attending 1 Sunday service, attending corporate prayer and engaging in lifegroup/small group accountability settings.
- 3. To live a life which honours Jesus and suitably represents Him and our church.
- 4. To love and honour the people which you serve and lead each week.
- 5. To live a self-controlled life, particularly with regards to alcohol, illegal substances and sexual immorality.
- 6. To ensure that all usage of social media or online forums is responsible and Christ like.
- 7. To refrain from any sectarian or racist behaviour or dialogue.
- 8. To follow the policies and procedures given by each individual ministry.
- 9. To attend any training or whole team meetings organised within each area of ministry.
- 10. To follow the church calendar of team responsibilities and to take personal responsibility to turn up each time that you are scheduled to serve.
- 11. If you are not available to serve on a week which you are scheduled to be on, to personally take responsibility to get someone to cover your duties, or to swap with someone from another team.

As set out in Believing and Belonging, the elders may prayerfully consider asking an individual to step aside from serving in emmanuel Church, if they feel that they are deliberately choosing to disregard these guidelines in anyway.
